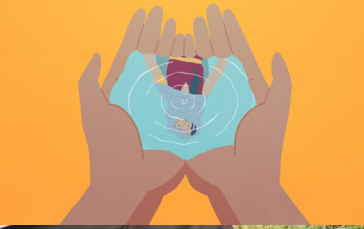

What is NUA:Origins?

NUA:Origins is an 8 part film series produced by Scripture Union Ireland. It is an engaging faith-based resource suitable for confirmation preparation (6th class), pre-confirmation (5th class), junior level religious education in secondary school and also for general youth ministry.

It is conversational in style, presented by three Irish young adults (two male and one female). It is full of relevant and honest stories of faith to create a safe space for young people to explore the core themes of the Christian faith and to help them discover how faith applies to their own lives.

Who is Scripture Union Ireland?

Scripture Union is an ecumenical Christian Organisation with over 50 years of ministry in Ireland engaging with over 6000 young people each year through retreats, parish and community-based youth ministry and providing resources for faith engagement with families and young people.

Topics & Programme:

Throughout the programme the young people will be engaging with topics such as at the nature of God and His creation 'Masterpiece', the meaning of Jesus's death 'Worth', Jesus's Resurrection 'New Beginnings', Prayer 'Connection', The Bible 'Story', the work of the Holy Spirit 'Guide', Jesus' Church 'Belong' and living as a Christian 'Journey'. Each week there will be a mixture of games, discussions, reflection and were possible, some light refreshments.
